NEGOMBO TO DAMBULLA (B, D)

APPROX. 6.5 HOURS DRIVE

Today, travel to the historic town of Dambulla. Upon arrival, head to the famed Dambulla Cave Temple, the largest and best-preserved cave temple complex in the country. This UNESCO World Heritage Site boasts 157 Buddha statues, along with intricate mural paintings. Learn about the unique history of the temple and admire the beautiful views of the countryside. This evening, join a safari at Minneriya National Park. This vast preserve is home to a wide variety of wildlife, including elephants, leopards, sambar deer and langur monkeys.

DAMBULLA (B, D)

APPROX. 1 HOUR DRIVE

The highlight of today is a visit to Sigiriya Rock Fortress, often referred to as the Eighth Wonder of the World. Rising out of the lush jungle, this rocky monolith is home to the remains of an ancient fortress built in the late fifth century. Sigiriya translates to 'Lion Rock', a reference to the way visitors traditionally began their final ascent to the top of the fortress: passing through the open jaw of a lion. Today, the only remains of this lion figure are the gigantic paws sculpted into the side of the rock.
